Some habitats are **EXTREME** and require special adaptations for the plants and animals to survive



Snowy Owls have their white plumage to camouflage them against the snowy tundra.

Burrowing Owls live in the hot desert, so spend a lot of the daytime hiding underground where it's cooler.



Eurasian Eagle Owls have long, broad wings which help it fly using minimal energy

Boobook Owls have found it's easier to find food in urban areas compared to their native scrub.



Barn Owls have a large flattened facial disc which channels sound into their ears so they can hunt more efficiently.
